SHORT SAFARI PROGRAM

The Exclusive Tanzania & Rwanda Explorer takes you on an exclusive 'Bucket List' adventure to experience the two most sought-after wildlife adventures in East Africa; first exploring 'The Great Migration' of the Serengeti, and next visiting the Volcanoes National Park for a close-up introduction to the endangered mountain gorillas of Africa.

Your safari starts with a scenic drive to the Serengeti National Park, which was established in 1952, covers almost 15,000 square kilometers, and features amazing landscapes, ranging from savannahs to woodlands and open grasslands dotted with rocky ridges. Which provides the backdrop for the world's largest seasonal animal migration with 1,5 million wildebeest, the largest population of big mammals still roaming the planet, 500,000 Thompson's gazelle, 250,000 zebra, followed by 20,000 eland trekking north across the Serengeti to the plains of the Mara at the beginning of the dry season. To reach their objective, the animals must cross two major rivers, the Grumeti River and the Mara River, where more than 3,000 crocodiles are waiting for the herds to appear. Add to that 3,000 lions, the largest concentration of big cats in the world, now living in the larger Serengeti ecosystem, which means that about 20% of the animals that make up 'The Great Migration' do not survive the journey one way or back six months later. The sight of the endless stream of animals crossing the rivers represents a well-established attraction for tourists and is a natural spectacle unlike anything the international traveler can expect to experience in this world.

The second part of your safari takes you to the Volcanoes National Park which is Rwanda's best-known park. It covers about 160 square kilometers of tropical rainforest on the slopes of five of the eight volcanoes of the Virunga volcano range and is home to the rare and endangered mountain gorillas and golden monkeys. The park was first gazetted as such in 1925 by the Belgian colonial administration, which makes it the oldest protected area in Africa. It borders Virunga

National Park in the Democratic Republic of Congo and Mgahinga Gorilla National Park in Uganda, thereby complementing the Virunga Conservation Area (VCA). The 434 square kilometers of the VCA also includes a string of eight volcanoes situated on the edge of the Albertine Rift Valley and stretching across the borders of the three adjacent countries.

Although the park is best known for its populations of mountain gorillas and golden monkeys, it also features other primates, in addition to over 180 recorded bird species, with at least 13 species and 16 subspecies endemic to the Virunga volcanoes and the Rwenzori Mountains. The slopes of the ancient volcano range, covered with rainforest and bamboo thickets, were also the base for American naturalist Dian Fossey, who operated a mountain gorilla research center in the saddle area between Mt. Karisimbi and Mt. Visoke between 1966 and 1985. She was killed by unknown assailants in 1985, a crime attributed to the poachers she had spent her life fighting. Dian Fossey is buried next to her famous gorillas at the research center, and her life and work were portrayed in the movie 'Gorillas in the Mist', based on her own biography by the same title.

ing tour and a transfer to the domestic departures area for a scheduled charter flight to the Seronera airstrip in the Serengeti NP.







Which provides the backdrop for the world's largest seasonal animal migration with 1,5 million wildebeest, the largest population of big mammals still roaming the planet, 500,000 Thompson's gazelle, 250,000 zebra, followed by 20,000 eland trekking north across the Serengeti to the plains of the Mara at the beginning of the dry season.

To reach their objective, the animals must cross two major rivers, the Grumeti River and the Mara River, where more than 3,000 crocodiles are waiting for the herds to appear. Add to that 3,000 lions, the largest concentration of big cats in the world, now living in the larger Serengeti ecosystem, which means that about 20% of the animals that make up 'The Great Migration' do not survive the journey one way or back six months later.

The sight of the endless stream of animals crossing the rivers represents a well-established attraction for tourists and is a natural spectacle unlike anything the international traveler can expect to experience in this world. Other mammals and predators found in the Serengeti NP are hippos, elephants, Cape buffalo, black rhinos, olive baboons, warthog, aardvark, leopard, lion, spotted hyena, jackal, honey badger, African civet cat, caracal, serval, banded mongoose, and pangolin. In addition, the park also has over 500 tropical bird species ranging from the Maasai ostrich, secretary bird, crowned crane, lesser flamingo, shoebill stork, fish eagle, pelican, various types of hornbills, many species of vultures, with black eagles soaring effortlessly above the golden savannahs of the Serengeti.

The primary landscapes of the larger Serengeti ecosystem can best be defined as follows. **Serengeti Plains**: Primarily features mostly treeless savannahs in the south, dotted with rocky ridges and granite formations that serve as observation platforms for predators. **Western Corridor**: This sector is predominately defined by a pair of rivers, the Grumeti and Mbalageti, which feature extensive riverine forests

and some small mountain ranges and stretch to Lake Victoria on its western border. The seasonal great migration passes through this corridor between May and July yearly. **Northern Serengeti:** It is dominated by open woodlands and ranges from the main settlement of Seronera in the south to the Mara River on the border with Kenya in the north. It is generally considered remote and relatively inaccessible.

Activity Option - Nature Walk- US \$ 60 Per Person

You have the optional opportunity to join a guided walking safari, which will provide you with the amazing opportunity to experience the wildlife and landscapes of the Serengeti National Park ecosystem up close.

Activity Option - Explore Maasai Boma - US \$ 100 Per Person

You can visit an authentic Maasai village and gain insights into their unique cultures and traditions. A village chief will lead a tour of the Boma and explain how Maasai traditions and lifestyles have remained unchanged for centuries. You also have the opportunity to watch or take part in traditional Maasai dance ceremonies.

Activity Option - Hot Air Balloon Safari - US \$ 600 Per Person

Starting early in the morning, you also have the option of joining a hot air balloon safari, with the balloon gliding silently over the savannah as you observe the wildlife below. This adventure features a bush breakfast after a successful landing.



The standard permit costs US \$ 1,500 per person and allows a group of eight visitors to have contact with a habituated gorilla family for one day.

Activity Option - Golden Monkey Tracking - US \$ 100 Per Person

Trekking the forest trails and slopes of the Volcanoes NP or any other part of the Virunga Conservation Area allows you to observe the rare golden monkeys, the smallest of the primates and an endangered species. The golden monkey is a subspecies of the blue monkey, with a golden patch on the upper flanks and back. It is at home in the same bamboo forests, which are preferred as the primary diet by the mountain gorillas.

Activity Option - Dian Fossey Trekking - US \$ 80 Per Person

And for all those interested in the scientific work of American naturalist Dian Fossey, trekking to her former mountain gorilla research center in the saddle area between Mt. Karisimbi and Mt. Visoke adds a historical dimension to your gorilla tracking adventure in the Volcanoes NP.

Activity Option - Volcano Trekking - US \$ 400 Per Person

You can also venture on an exciting two-day climb of Mount Karisimbi, one of five Virunga volcanoes within the park boundaries of the Volcanoes NP.
